

Hello, here are things to remember for driving

right of way, belongs to the main road or the first person at a four way stop (not every side may have a stop sign so check)

front wheel drive to go straight up, rear wheel drive to reverse up, four wheel drive for mud and traction

full stop before changing gears else you might blow the transmission

hauled loads may come through the back window

parking lot, neighborhood, store, highway, interstate
15, 25, 35, 55, 65, 75

if the gas is stuck, put the car in neutral
if the brakes wont work, use the e-brake

if someone tries to use a pit maneuver on you, turn into it and accelerate

semi truck going down a hill, don't be in front of it
semi truck changing lanes, don't be in that lane until it passes

railroad crossings and fire hydrants, maintain distance

stop for buses

pull over for cops/medics/firemen or change lanes if they are on the side of the road

slow down for heavy loads and funeral cars

slow down for construction

make hazard stops for pot holes, wildlife, pedestrians, lane ending, car accidents, and traffic

left arrow on red might smack someone going right on red or someone going through a yellow light

wait for left arrow on red or until other side has completed going straight through

their could be no right turn on red or their might be a no stop lane ahead

you could be in a turn only lane

a missed exit is better than an unsafe pass

when getting onto the highway, be almost up to speed because you are still in a yield lane
when you are on the highway and see someone getting on, you have more reaction time

stay in your lane when going through a light, before changing lanes

stay in the lane closest to you when turning through an intersection

when going through the city you may want to stay one lane away from the sides because many parked cars are usually there

keep your eyes scanning in a tight cone so you don't get hypnotized and so you keep focused

ADHD, short term memory loss, stress, diet, sleep, distractions change may affect driving

deal with distraction and direction before driving

stopping and going on a 2 confirmation basis

mirrors wide enough to see merging lanes and blind spots

signal 100ft before turning so people know to slow down

speed, exit, pass, co-ordinate

hands, mirrors, middle of car, speed, signs, road

going over hills and around corners slow down because you can't see traffic ahead

go slower at lights to give reaction space and accuracy

15mph turning

35mph coming off highway

stop at lights with enough space for turning cars and walking pedestrians

go the speed limit or the speed of the car in front of you

distance of 20ft

don't glance at your speed too much, keep your foot steady

brights only in use 500ft

hydroplaning happens at 35mph during rain, oil, wind, and ice
bridges freeze sooner because of wind

a seat belt may save you from a front collision, but no seat belt may save you from a side collision

turn ignition off at gas pumps

when passing other cars make sure you see them in your mirrors and the closest window while having braking space ahead (3 second rule, 20ft minimum)

other cars might be also turning into the lane you are getting in

don't forget the people who are in front of you when passing who might stop, and others who might get in front of you suddenly
it is better to pass cars on a straight clear road
(motorcycles may sneak past this so if you hear them you might want to wait)

when passing turns make sure your mirrors or the middle of your car has clearance

relax or you wont be flexible

tap breaks so they catch

1-2 second breaks looking away from road

road signs, post signs, my signs, car signs

look both ways crossing and backing
open door and window if need be

using your hoods corners and your hands in the middle of the road to make sharp turns

using the mirrors to back out of a parking space
using the middle of the car to pull forward out of a parking space
using mirrors to come to the edge of the road

lights
wipers
tires air and bolts
battery
steering
all brakes
fuel
leaks
hood
drive shaft
tie rods

ice breaker
jumper cables
towing company
tire stuff
extra coolant or etc.
mechanic shops
phone with charger
wallet and insurance
keys
