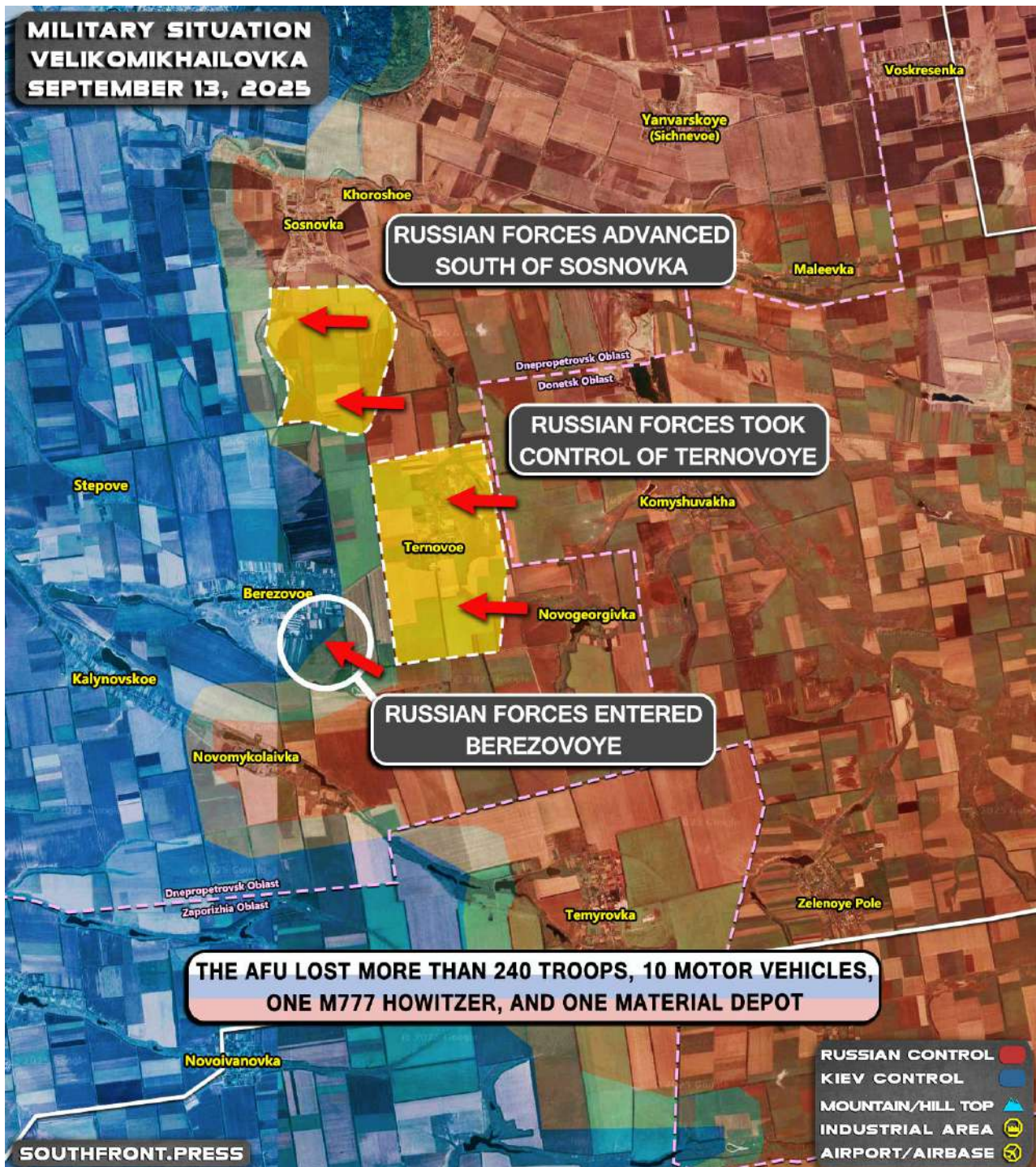


Military Situation In Ukraine On September 13, 2025 (Maps Update)

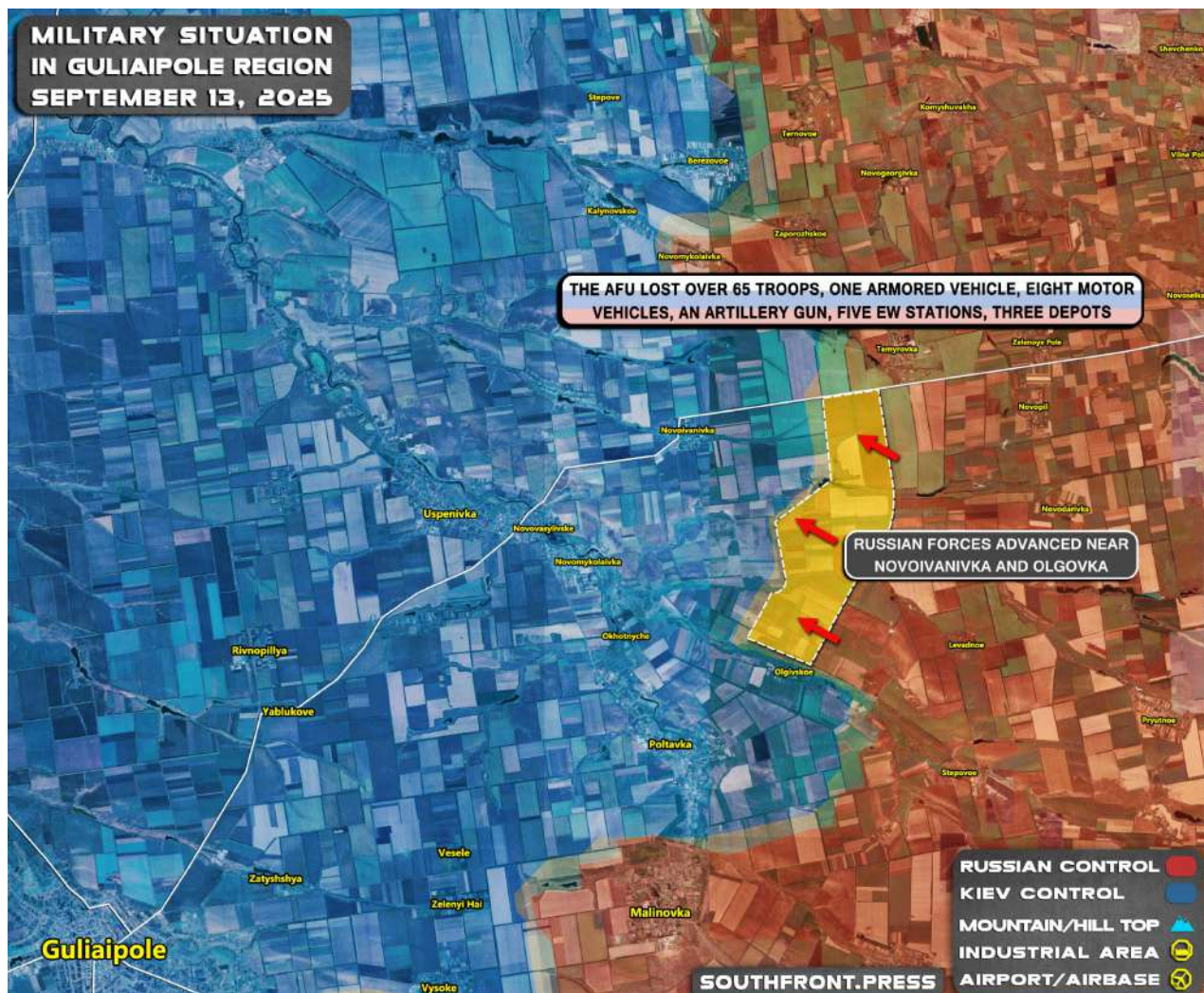
September 13, 2025

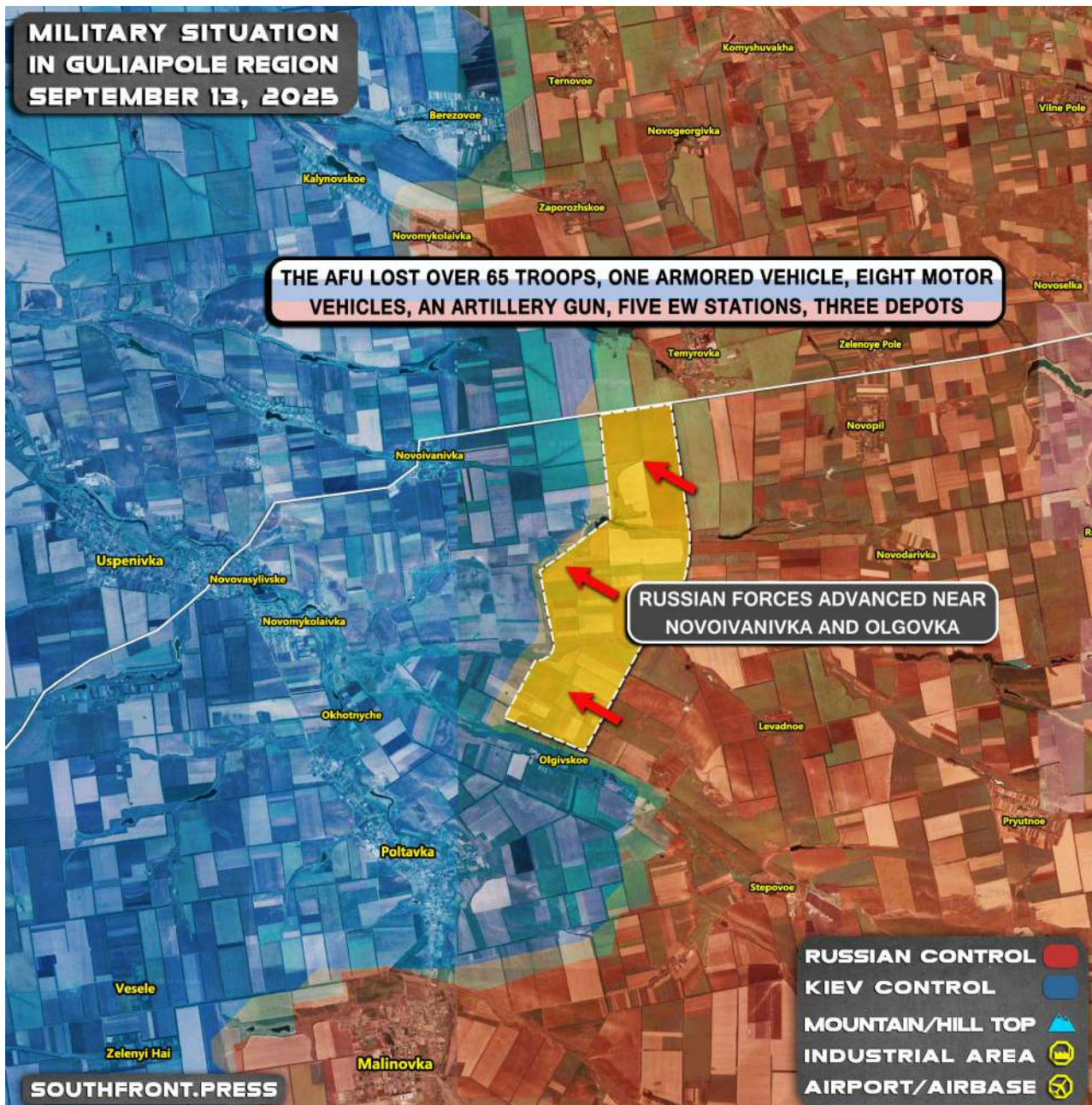


- Russian strikes destroyed targets in the Zaporizhzhia, Kharkiv, Mykolaiv, Sumy, Kherson, Odessa and the Donbass regions;
- Russian forces struck a temporary deployment point of AFU personnel in Kalynovo;
- Russian forces struck a temporary deployment point of AFU personnel in Sloviansk;
- Russian offensive continues in Konstantinovka, Kupyansk, Mirnograd, Velyka Novosilka, Svatove directions;
- Russian forces took control of Ternovoye;
- Russian forces advanced in Gulyai Pole direction;
- Russian forces advanced in Svatove direction;
- Russian forces advanced in Konstantinovka direction;
- Ukrainian losses amounted to approximately 1,370 troops in the past 24 hours.



- Russian forces took control of Ternovoye;
- Russian forces entered Berezovoye;
- Russian forces advanced south of Sosnovka;
- The AFU lost more than 240 troops, 10 motor vehicles, one U.S.-made 155-mm M777 howitzer, and had one material depot destroyed.

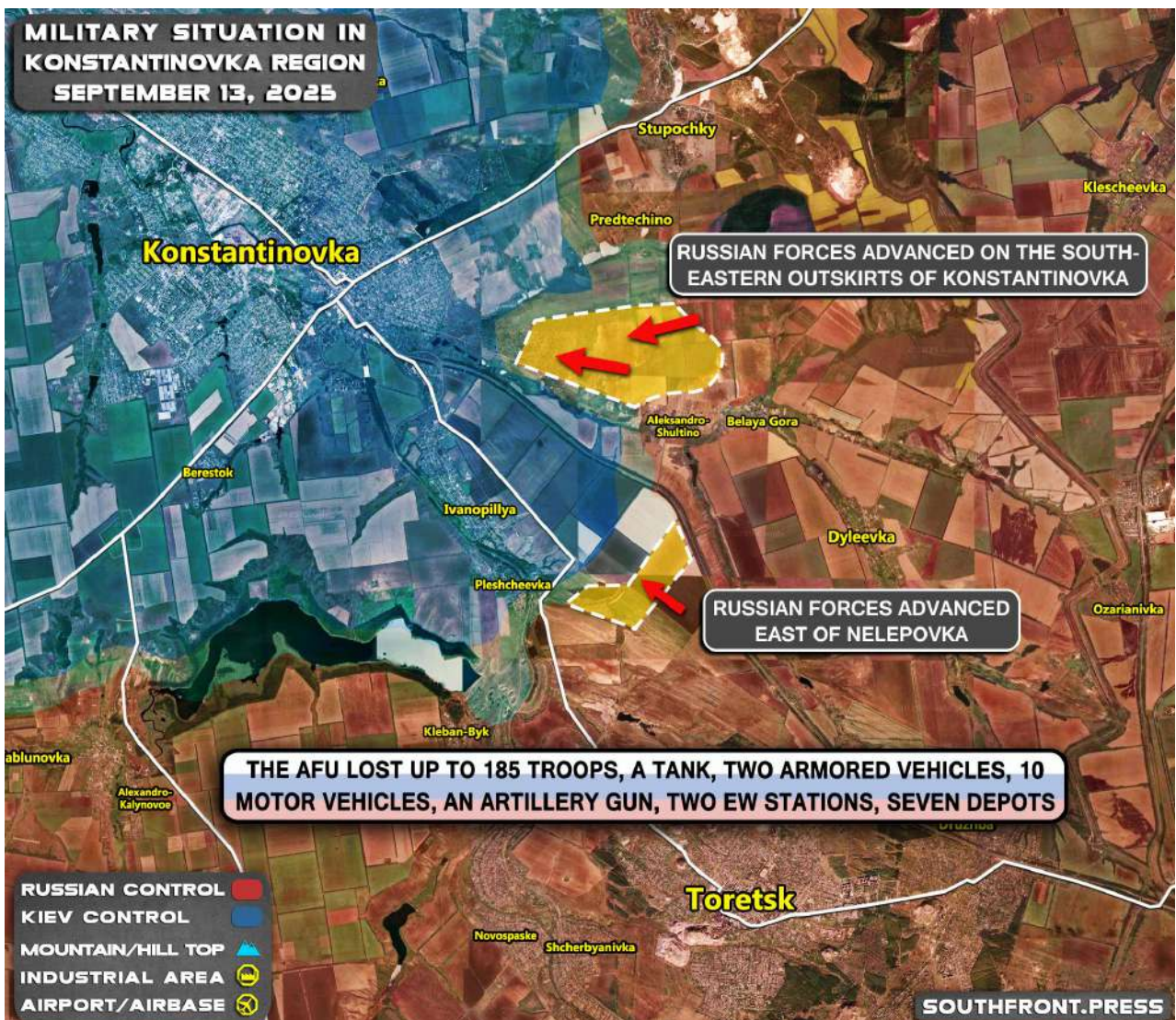




- Russian forces advanced near Novoivanivka and Olgovka;
- The AFU lost over 65 troops, one armored fighting vehicle, eight motor vehicles, an artillery gun, and had five electronic warfare stations and three depots neutralized.

- Russian forces advanced on the southeastern outskirts of Konstantinovka;
- Russian forces advanced east of Nelepovka;
- The AFU lost up to 185 troops, a tank, two armored fighting vehicles, 10 motor vehicles, an artillery gun, and had two electronic warfare stations and seven depots neutralized.
